## Guide to downloading large files for assessors

If the exam administrator has given students the option of using the 'Large files' upload function, for files larger than 50 MB, downloading files to your computer functions slightly differently than without the use of 'Large files'.

1. Click 'Download all hand-ins':

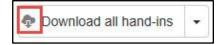
*Result:* A message will appear on the screen informing you that processing your files for download may take several minutes.

The hand-ins are being packed into a zip-file. This can take several minutes. When the f is ready, you will be able to download it by pressing "Download all hand-ins" again.
You can continue to use the system while the zip-file is being generated.

While the system is processing your files, a wheel will be visible to the left of the 'Download all hand-ins' box:



2. When the system has finished processing your files, the wheel will be replaced by a cloud. Click the button again. Now all of the students' papers, front pages and appendices can be downloaded.
