

When do you need to contact the RSO with the relevant information?

In the table below you can see deadlines for researchers from Arts for sending material to RSO in order to receive a budget and feedback.

E.g. If you intend to apply for Velux - Praksisopslag, we must receive your budget information 3 weeks prior to the deadline and a draft of the proposal 4 weeks before deadline. Budget information means that you need to answer in writing the questions asked in the document 'RSO Budget questions'. Getting feedback on your proposal requires sending the RSO a draft by the deadline.

Please note that the RSO also has implemented the following changes:

- Only courses and self-help tools are available for PhD-students and postdocs (Incoming Marie Curie IF excluded)
- Only proposals of DKK 500.000 or more are supported
- Carlsberg Postdoc and DFF–International Postdoc are not supported
- The AR Finance will handle rebudgetting of previous proposals.
