

ARE YOU GDPR COMPLIANT IN YOUR RESEARCH?

DURING YOUR RESEARCH PROJECT

During your research project, you should regularly consider whether anything has changed in the way you process personal data.

Are you still processing the same type of personal data about the same people and the same number of people?

Do you need to share personal data with others?

Do you need to process personal data for longer than you expected?

Has anything else changed?

If you make changes to your research project, please always remember to:

Update your risk assessment and (if relevant) your impact assessment.

Inform the data subjects of any changes (if these changes are significant). Register your changes in the AU record.

Have you received an enquiry f rom a data subject? If so, please be aware of the data subject's rights.

Has a personal data breach occurred? Or do you suspect that it has? If so, you need to report it.
