Nemmere ansøgningsproces for studerende med handicap

Særlige prøvevilkår – hvad går den nye proces ud på?

Fra efteråret 2021 indføres der en ny proces for tildeling af særlige prøvevilkår til studerende med handicap/varige funktionsnedsættelser.

Processen går ud på, at studerende med handicap kun behøver at søge om særlige prøvevilkår én gang. Det betyder, at når først den studerende er registreret med særlige behov, vil den studerende hvert semester få et brev fra Studienævnet med oplysninger om de tildelte prøvevilkår i den kommende eksamenstermin.

Det er dog vigtigt at tilføje, at denne nye proces kun gælder for dispensationsansøgninger om særlige prøvevilkår til eksamen (herunder også til specialer). Hvis den studerende ønsker dispensation fra andre regler, skal han/hun fortsat indsende en ansøgning gennem selvbetjeningen.

Hvad kan/skal du gøre?

Hvis du som underviser bliver kontaktet af en studerende med spørgsmål vedrørende dispensationsansøgninger, er det vigtigt, at du fortsat henviser ham/hende enten til [en studievejleder](#), som kan vejlede den studerende konkret, eller til [Studiecenter Arts](#).

Undervisningsmiljøvurdering

Der kommer i efteråret til at foregå en proces for undervisningsmiljøvurdering.

Processen tager udgangspunkt i den seneste afholdte nationale undersøgelse fra Uddannelses- og forskningsministeriet, hvor alle studerende er blevet stillet spørgsmål om deres undervisningsmiljø og studiemiljø.

Undervisningsmiljøvurderingen er en vurdering af universitetets fysiske, psykiske og æstetiske miljø og skal efter lovkrav udføres på universiteter hvert 3. år. Processen minder på mange måder om en APV på uddannelsesområdet. Formålet med vurderingen er, at udpege hvis der er områder, hvor der er behov for en indsats for at udvikle og sikre et godt undervisningsmiljø for de studerende.

Studerende på Arts modtager inden længe information om undervisningsmiljøvurderingen og bliver inviteret til at kontakte deres repræsentant i uddannelsesnævnet, såfremt de har ønsker om at bidrage til drøftelserne.

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Internationalisering

534 udvekslingsstuderende ankommer til Aarhus Universitet i efteråret 2021. Fordeling på de enkelte fakulteter ser sådan ud: Arts: 156; BSS: 236; Health: 24; NAT: 70; TEK: 48.

Arts Internationalisation ser frem til at byde velkommen til 156 nye indkommende udvekslingsstuderende i efteråret samt akademisk år 21-22. Hjemuniversiteterne spænder bredt fra Wisconsin-Madison til Manipal til Waseda. Pladserne på de Internationale valgfag (IV-fagene) var meget efterspurgt og de studerende glæder sig til Arts Intro Days samt semesterstart i løbet af august.

Studiestartsoplæg

Arts Karriere deltager i den kommende studiestart for alle nye bachelorstuderende. Oplægget vil sætte fokus på de nye studerendes egne overvejelser omkring et fremtidigt arbejdsliv og vil forsøge at bidrage til, at de studerende kan sænke skuldrene. Easier application process for students with disabilities

Special terms and conditions for exams

In the autumn of 2021 we are introducing a new process for allowing students with disabilities to take exams under special conditions.

This process means that students with disabilities only need to apply for special exam conditions once. Students whose special needs have been registered will receive a letter from the Board of Studies each semester containing information about the conditions applying to their exams in the upcoming exam period.

However, please note that this new process only applies to applications for dispensation connected to special conditions for exams (including theses). Students who would like dispensation in connection with other rules must continue to submit applications via the self-service system.

How does this affect you?

Teachers who are contacted by students with questions about applications for dispensation should continue to refer these students either to [a student counsellor](#), who can give students specific advice, or to [the Study Centre Arts](#).

Assessment of teaching environment (Undervisningsmiljøvurdering)

A process regarding the assessment of teaching environment (Undervisningsmiljøvurdering) will be conducted during the autumn.

This process is based on the latest national survey conducted by the Ministry of Higher Education and Science, in which students are asked questions about their teaching environment and study environment.

The assessment of the teaching environment covers the university's physical, psychological and aesthetic environment. It is a legal requirement that this assessment is conducted once every three years. In many ways, the process is similar to the process involved in a workplace assessment (APV). The objective is to identify any areas in which special efforts are needed to develop and ensure a good teaching environment for the students.

Students at the Faculty of Arts will soon be receiving information about the teaching environment

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assessment, and will be invited to contact their representative on the Degree Programme Board if they want to contribute to the discussions.

534 exchange students will be coming to study at Aarhus University in the autumn of 2021. They will be studying at the following faculties: Arts: 156; BSS: 236; Health: 24; NAT: 70; TECH: 48.

These students come from many different universities, ranging from Wisconsin-Madison to Manipal and Waseda. There was great demand for places on our international electives (IV courses), and the students are looking forward to the Arts Intro Days and the start of the semester in August.

Arts Karriere and the introduction week

Arts Karriere will be taking part in the upcoming introduction week for all new BA students. They will be making a presentation focusing on how the new students feel about their future working lives, and will try to help them relax a bit in this connection. The presentation will encourage the students to reflect on their situation, express any doubts they may have, and talk to each other in general about careers.

Arts Karriere will also be making an introductory presentation for a number of the new MA students, but other presentations are also welcome. They don't necessarily have to be made during the introductory week itself. They can also be made later in the autumn.
