TIL ORIENTERING

Sprogpolitik – påmindelse om gældende regler

Arts sprogpolitik trådte i kraft for alle studieordninger på Arts pr. 1. september 2020 i forlængelse af at Styrelsen for forskning og uddannelse fastsatte nye rammer for undervisnings- og eksamenssprog. Da reglerne for eksamenssprog fortsat er forholdsvis nye, ønsker SNUK at minde om reglerne og vigtigheden af, at undervisere kender reglerne og fortæller de studerende om dem i forbindelse med introduktion til eksamen eller til faget generelt.

Regeloverblik:

På dansk akkrediterede uddannelser

- foregår undervisning og eksamen på dansk eller engelsk, afhængigt af hvem der underviser eller formålet med faget (begrundelsen for at undervise på engelsk skal være faglig eller arbejdsmarkedsrelevant). Institutleder er ansvarlig for, at mindre end halvdelen af uddannelsen undervises på engelsk. Underviser må efterkomme ønske fra studerende om at aflægge eksamen på dansk, selvom undervisningen er foregået på engelsk, og omvendt.

På engelsk akkrediterede uddannelser

- foregår al undervisning og eksamen alene på engelsk. Underviser må *ikke* aftale andet med studerende.

På dansk akkrediterede uddannelser i sprog og sprogbaseede områdestudier

- foregår undervisning og eksamen på dansk, engelsk eller det studerede sprog. Hvis sprogkundskab er en del af de faglige mål, kan underviser ikke aftale med studerende, at de aflægge eksamen på andre sprog end det studerede sprog. Hvis sprogkundskab *ikke* er en del af de faglige mål, kan underviser imødekomme studerendes ønske om at aflægge eksamen på dansk, selvom undervisningen er foregået på engelsk, og omvendt.

På engelsk akkrediterede uddannelser i sprog og sprogbaseede områdestudier

- foregår undervisning og eksamen på engelsk eller det studerede sprog. Hvis sprogkundskab er en del af de faglige mål, må underviser ikke aftale med studerende, at de aflægge eksamen på andre sprog end det studerede sprog. Hvis sprogkundskab *ikke* er en del af de faglige mål, må underviser imødekomme studerendes ønske om at aflægge eksamen på dansk, selvom undervisningen er foregået på engelsk, og omvendt.

USEFUL INFORMATION

Language policy – a reminder of the current rules

The faculty's language policy came into effect for all our academic regulations as of 1 September 2020, following the definition of a new framework for the language of teaching and exams by the Danish Agency for Science and Higher Education.

The rules for the language of exams are still relatively new, so SNUK would like to remind you of these rules and underline how important it is that teachers are familiar with them, and that they tell their students about them when introducing exams or courses in general.

Summary of the rules:

On Danish-accredited degree programmes

- The teaching and exams are conducted in Danish or English, depending on the teacher or the objective of the course in question (teaching in English is only possible based on course-specific or labour-market considerations). The Head of School is responsible for ensuring that less than half of the degree programme is taught in English. Teachers may comply with any requests by students to take exams in Danish, even though the teaching has been conducted in English (and vice versa).

On English-accredited degree programmes

- All the teaching and exams must be conducted in English. Teachers may *not* reach any other agreements with students.

On Danish-accredited degree programmes in languages and language-based area studies

- The teaching and exams are conducted in Danish, English, or the language that is being studied. If language proficiency is one of the academic objectives of the course, teachers must not allow the students to take the exam in any language other than the language being studied. If language proficiency is *not* one of the academic objectives, teachers may comply with requests by students to take exams in Danish even though the teaching has been conducted in English (and vice versa).

On English-accredited degree programmes in languages and language-based area studies

- The teaching and exams are conducted in English or the language being studied. If language proficiency is one of the academic objectives of the course, teachers must not allow the students to take the exam in any language other than the language being studied. If language proficiency is *not* one of the academic objectives, teachers may comply with requests by students to take exams in Danish even though the teaching has been conducted in English (and vice versa).
