Trivsels- og aktivitetspuljen er åben for ansøgninger fra foreninger, studerende og ansatte

AU har bevilliget Arts 250.000 kr. til genstart af studielivet efter genåbningen. Midlerne skal støtte lokale initiativer, der har fokus på at styrke de studerendes (re-)integration i uddannelsesmiljøerne. Derfor er der oprettet en Trivsels- og aktivitetspulje, som foreninger, studerende og ansatte med ideer til aktiviteter for Arts-studerende kan søge tilskud fra.

Puljen har på lidt under en måned modtaget 20 ansøgninger og uddelt for ca. 25.000 kr.

New fund for clubs and societies, students and staff

AU has granted the Faculty of Arts DKK 250,000 to support post-lockdown activities and initiatives. The money is intended to help the process of (re-)integrating the students into their study environment. It has been invested in a wellbeing/activity fund which welcomes applications from clubs, societies, students and staff who have good ideas for activities for students at the Faculty of Arts.

In just under a month, the fund has received 20 applications and disbursed about DKK 25,000.
