26 Summer University courses have now been approved by the boards of studies and set up in the systems. These courses can be found [here](#) in the course catalogue.

The courses are distributed as follows:

School of Communication and Culture: 14 registered (four new and ten being offered again) – all internationalisation courses

School of Culture and Society: Seven registered (four new and three being offered again) – all internationalisation courses

Danish School of Education (DPU) Five registered (four new and one being offered again) – four elective courses on the Master's degree programme in educational sociology and one elective course in educational philosophy. Three of these will be conducted in Emdrup, and two in Aarhus.
