Indmeldelse af Internationaliseringsvalgfag på IKK og IKS

Indkaldelsen af næste omgang internationaliseringsvalgfag (IV-fag), som skal udbydes E23/F24 er sat i gang. Hver afdelingsleder er i år ansvarlig for at indmelde:

- 2 kurser placeret i efteråret, hvis afdelingens uddannelser har IV-fag i efteråret
- 1-2 kurser placeret i foråret, hvis afdelingens uddannelser har IV-fag i foråret
- 1 + 1 kursus placeret henholdsvis efterår og forår, hvis afdelingens uddannelser har IV-fag både efterår og forår

Har man bemanding til at dublere eller melde flere ind end ovenstående, er det en mulighed.

Information about studying abroad in the supplementary subject year

On 4 October, the Student Guidance and Information office will have an online information meeting on taking the self-designed supplementary subject abroad (ITTU). The same information meeting was held on 26 September. The meetings aim to inform students who wish to study abroad as part of their supplementary subject year in the academic year 23/24 about rules, procedures and deadlines for doing so. The information is also available on the [ITTU page on the study portal](#).

In week 43 (24-28 October), the local student counsellors will have an information meeting for third semester BA students on other options during their supplementary subject year. Here, students are also welcome to ask questions about studying abroad in case they did not attend one of the online meetings. Students who want more information on exchange programs and inspiration for studying abroad can also register for the [Arts Study Abroad Inspiration Meeting](#) taking place on 6 October.

IMPORTANT DEADLINES

Registration of internationalisation electives at CC and CAS

It is now possible to submit proposals for internationalisation electives to be offered in the autumn 2023/spring 2024. This year, each head of department is responsible for registering:

- 2 courses in the autumn if the department's degree programmes include internationalisation electives in the autumn.
- 1-2 courses in the spring if the department's degree programmes include internationalisation electives in the spring.
- 1 + 1 course in the spring and autumn semester, respectively, if the department's degree programmes include internationalisation electives in both the autumn and spring.

If you have sufficient staffing to duplicate courses or register more courses than described above, this is also an option.

The registration deadline is 21 November 2022 via the [online form](#). Here, you will also find an overview of [the placement of internationalisation courses](#) in each individual degree programme.
