Ændringer i studieordninger pr. 1. september 2022

Status på antal aktive studieordninger på Arts

På Arts har der i flere år været fokus på at nedbringe antallet af studieordninger. I september 2022 har vi **242 aktive studieordninger**. Til sammenligning var antallet **436** i juli 2017.

Arts har **177 "uddannelsesretninger"** – altså bachelor-, kandidat-, masteruddannelser, bachelor- og kandidattilvalg.

Internationalisering

623 nye udvekslingsstuderende er blevet indskrevet på Aarhus Universitet i efteråret 2022. Fordeling på de enkelte fakulteter er: BSS 282; Arts 188; NAT 63; TEK 52; Health 38.

Arts Internationalisation var vært for et storstilet *Intro Days*-arrangement i uge 34. Ud fra deltagelsen og ikke mindst den højlydte respons samt engagement fra de nye studerende, kan man ikke være i tvivl om, at de er meget glade for at være på campus her i Aarhus og er ivrige efter at komme i gang med studielivet i Danmark.

Hjemuniversiteterne spænder bredt fra Melbourne, Kobe, Cork, Wien til Californien mm. Pladserne på de Internationale valgfag har været meget efterspurgt, og der er bestemt en del studerende, som vil have rigtig travlt om mandagen.

Email to all teaching staff at the start of the autumn semester

Academic regulations at the Faculty of Arts

The Faculty of Arts has been focusing on reducing the number of academic regulations for several years now. In September 2022 we have **242 active academic regulations**. The corresponding number in July 2017 was **436**.

The faculty has **177 lines of study** (Bachelor's degree programmes, Master's degree programmes, professional Master's degree programmes and Bachelor's/Master's supplementary degree programmes).

Internationalisation

623 new exchange students were enrolled at Aarhus University in the autumn of 2022. They are studying at the following faculties: BSS 282; Arts 188; NAT 63; TEK 52; Health 38.

Arts Internationalisation hosted a major *Intro Days* event in week 34 (22-26 August). The level of participation, and not least the enthusiastic response and sense of commitment emanating from the new

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students, show clearly that they are delighted to be on campus here in Aarhus, and that they are keen to start their lives as students in Denmark.

They come from universities as far apart as Melbourne, Kobe, Cork, Vienna and California. Our international electives have proved particularly popular, and there's no doubt that a good number of students are going to be really busy on Mondays.

Is it too soon to think about a career?

Arts Karriere also came along in week 34 to meet the new students, who were both nervous and curious. A lot of people might feel overwhelmed by questions about career perspectives in the very first week of their university studies. So the consultants from Arts Karriere do their best to explain that careers don't necessarily run in straight lines. It's natural to have a few doubts, and there are plenty of paths leading to a good career. We know that job prospects are an important factor when students choose their degree programmes. We know this because we have asked them – and you will find examples of their responses on [Arts Karriere's Instagram](#).
