Status på omprøverne i V22/V23

Opdatering af studieportalen med nye medlemmer i studienævn og uddannelsesnævn

Studieportalen opdateres pr. 1. februar 2023 med de nye medlemmer af [studienævn](#) og [uddannelsesnævn](#) og efter konstituering også med angivelse af hhv. forpersoner og næstforpersoner.

Udvekslingsnyt 2023-2024

423 studerende på Arts har i december søgt udvekslingspladser i udlandet til det kommende akademiske år 2023-24. Ansøgerne havde tilsammen 2696 prioriteter, fordelt på 223 forskellige partneruniversiteter. Partneruniversiteter i Australien samt Canada er fortsat særdeles populære.

352 er blevet tilbudt en plads, mens 71 er henvist til at søge igen pr. 1. maj (udrejsende foråret 2024), eller kontakte internationalt team for en mulig restplads (ved planlagt udrejse i efteråret 2023).

Til semesterstart i foråret 2023 byder Arts velkommen til 129 nye indrejsende udvekslingsstuderende. Dertil er der 70 af efterårets indrejsende, som er på et helt års udveksling, og dermed forsætter deres studier her på Arts i dette forår.

Studiecenteret har holdt oplæg for de nye exchange-studerende

Den 26. januar afholdt Studiecenteret et oplæg for de nye exchange-studerende. Oplæggets formål var at forberede de studerende på at gå til eksamen på Arts, oplyse dem om de vigtigste regler og deadlines ifm. eksamen og sørge for, at de ved, hvem de kan kontakte, hvis de oplever problemer med eksamen eller har brug for hjælp.

Arts CompanyDating bliver sparket i gang med to runder af One Minute Madness i Nobelauditoriet, hvor hver virksomhed har et minut til at præsentere sig selv og deres medbragte stillingsopslag.

Som optakt til Arts CompanyDating er det [Arts Karriereuge](#) fra 27. februar - 1. marts. Her kan de studerende deltage i morgen- og middagstalks online. De vil få gode tips til CV, ansøgning, LinkedIn og netværk. Derudover vil der være en alumne- og virksomhedstalk, så de studerende kan få indblik i forskellige brancher og arbejdsopgaver. De studerende kan møde repræsentanter fra Arts Karriere i deres lokale kantine i karriereugen og i ugen op til karriereugen.

Practical questions during the teaching period

The new semester has just started, and the spring courses have just got off the ground.

Re-examinations, winter 22/23

The spring semester has now begun – and so have the winter re-examinations. As of 30.01, 1.947 students have registered for re-examinations at the Faculty of Arts. If students or teachers have any questions about these re-examinations, please contact the relevant UVAEKA team.

Updating the study portal to include new members of the board of studies and degree programme boards

The study portal will be updated as of 1 February 2023 to include new members of [the board of studies](#) and [degree programme boards](#), with the chairs and deputy chairs being added once they have been appointed.

Exchange programmes 2023-24

In December, 423 students at the Faculty of Arts applied for exchange places abroad in the 2023-24 academic year. These applicants had a total of 2,696 priorities divided into 223 different partner universities. Our partner universities in Australia and Canada are still very popular.

352 students have been offered a place; while 71 have been told to apply again by 1 May (for departure in the spring of 2024), or to contact the international team and ask if there are any places remaining (for planned departure in the autumn of 2023).

At the start of the spring semester 2023, the Faculty of Arts is welcoming 129 new exchange students.

There are also about 70 exchange students from the autumn semester who are staying in Denmark for a whole year. So they will be continuing their studies at the Faculty of Arts this spring.

Presentation for new exchange students by the Study Centre

On 26 January the Study Centre gave a presentation to the new exchange students. The aim of this presentation was to prepare the students to take exams at the Faculty of Arts, to inform them of the most important rules and deadlines for exams, and to make sure they know who to contact if they have any problems with exams or need any other kind of help.

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New Power BI reports

The new report on [corporate relations](#) collects information about relations between students and companies based on various kinds of collaboration, such as:

- Internships
- Writing your thesis in collaboration with a company
- Companies employing students on courses of continuing and further education (if the company concerned is paying for the course)

This data can be shown for each student or each company, categorised in terms of the type of collaboration involved, the name of the company, the name of the municipality, the sector in question, the company size, and the faculty, degree programme and campus respectively.

The report on [the transition of graduates to the labour market](#) contains selected key figures about this transition, categorised in terms of the level of degree programme of the graduates concerned. The report collects key figures from existing reports on the following topics:

- Internships, and writing your thesis in collaboration with a company
- Survey of graduates 1-2 years after graduation
- Survey of graduates 5-6 years after graduation
- Unemployment among graduates
- Labour market status:
 - Proportion of graduates in the private sector
 - Employment categorised by sector
 - Employment categorised by company size
- Time taken to find your first job

Supplementary Subject Fair 2023

The Supplementary Subject Fair is to be held on 9 February this year. This event gives students planning their supplementary subjects the chance to gain some inspiration, and will help them to make their choice. The Student House is being renovated at the moment, so the event can't be held face to face this year. Instead, the students can watch videos about supplementary subjects from 26 January onwards (check the website), after which they can meet student counsellors for each supplementary subject at an event in Stakladen on 9 February. Arts Career Week and Arts CompanyDating

Arts Karriere are holding the event known as [Arts CompanyDating](#) on 2 March in the Nobel Cafeteria at 13:00-16:00. All students at the Faculty of Arts are invited. The students can meet 40 companies and organisations who are ready to talk about internships, student jobs, project collaborations, voluntary work and full-time employment. The students will be given feedback about how to write CVs and job applications, and they can even get a professional photo taken for their CVs. Arts CompanyDating starts with two rounds of One Minute Madness in the Nobel Lecture Theatre, with each company being given one minute to present themselves and the jobs that they can offer.

Arts CompanyDating will be preceded by the [Arts Career Week](#) on 27 February-1 March. This event gives students the chance to take part in online talks both in the mornings and at lunchtime. They can get useful tips about writing CVs and applications, LinkedIn and networks. There will also be an alumnus and company discussion giving the students insight into various sectors and aspects of the labour market. The students can meet representatives of Arts Karriere in their local cafeteria both during the Career Week and in the preceding week.
