TIL ORIENTERING

Fristudsættelser ved eksamen

Efter ønske fra studienævn og aftale med studielederne på IKS, IKK og DPU ændrer Arts Studier fra og med vintereksamen 23/24 på praksis for udsættelse af afleveringsfrister for studerende, der får dispensation til særlige prøvevilkår: Ved fristudsættelser beregnet til aflevering efter kl. 14.00 forlænges fristen til den følgende dag kl. 14.00. Dvs. hvis en studerende får dispensation til fristudsættelse til torsdag kl. 23.00, bliver den faktiske afleveringsfrist fredag kl. 14.00.

Ændringen omfatter ikke tilsynsprøver med planlagte afleveringstidspunkter efter kl. 14.00

Baggrunden for ændringen er et ønske om at undgå, at studerende kompenseres med ekstra timer der ligger om aftenen/natten. Samtidig kan der med ét fast afleveringstidspunkt sikres den bedste tekniske og administrative understøttelse for alle studerende i tilfælde af problemer med aflevering af eksamen.

Ændringen træder i kraft fra 1. september 2023.

USEFUL INFORMATION

Postponement of exam deadlines

At the request of the boards of studies and by agreement with the directors of studies at the School of Culture and Society, the School of Communication and Culture and the Danish School of Education, Arts Studies Administration will change its practice from the winter exams 2023/24 regarding postponement of submission deadlines for students who have been granted special exam terms and conditions. As to postponements in connection with submission after 14:00, the deadline is extended to the following day at 14:00. This means that if a student is granted postponement of a deadline until Thursday at 23:00, the actual submission deadline will be Friday at 14:00.

The change does not apply to on-site exams with scheduled submission deadlines after 14:00.

The reason for the change is to avoid students being compensated with extra hours in the evening/at night. With one fixed submission deadline, the best technical and administrative support can also be ensured for all students in case of problems with the submission of assignments.

The change takes effect on 1 September 2023.

New further and continuing education subsite on the study portal

Over the past few months, Arts Studies Administration has been working to create a new [further and continuing education](#) subsite on the study portal, which has now been launched.

Special rules apply to further and continuing education, and these students have other information needs than full-time students – needs that will be met with the new subsite. The subsite on the study portal has been created in the context of the pages about [admission](#) aimed at future students. However, students who have been admitted to a further and continuing education programme will find the information they need on the study portal. From now on, links will be provided to the subsite in connection with admission, and teaching staff, programme coordinators etc. are encouraged to refer to it.

There is a specific page for professional Master's degree students, part-time students and single-course students, respectively.

The exam dates for the summer 2024 will be announced shortly.

Exam presentations for first-semester students

As in previous years, UVAEKA will give presentations to first-semester students, so that they are well-equipped to take their first exams. This year, the presentations will primarily take place on site.

Coffee with the Danish Accreditation Institution on 17 November

The first step in the process of renewing the institutional accreditation has been taken with the submission of AU's institutional report, which contains a description of the university's quality assurance system and a self-assessment of quality assurance at all organisational levels.

The next step in the process will be taken in December, when the expert panel that will submit the final recommendation regarding renewal to the Accreditation Council will visit AU. The panel will meet with management, staff and students across the faculties, and will return in the spring, when the panel will take a closer look at selected degree programmes.
