### **Ændringer i studieordninger pr. 1. september 2023**

1. september trådte studieordningsændringer i kraft for de fleste studieordninger på Arts. Der er i år ekstraordinært mange ændringer i studieordningerne grundet fjernelse af forudsætningskrav. ### **Status på EVU-efteroptag efter ansøgningsfristen 21. august**

2. maj var der ansøgningsfrist til EVU-udbuddet (Masteruddannelser og hel-på-del), og frem til 21. august har der været åbent for efteroptag. I perioden er der på DPU efteroptaget 59 studerende, hvoraf 18 påbegynder en fuld masteruddannelse. På IKS er der efteroptaget 11 studerende, hvoraf 3 påbegynder en fuld masteruddannelse. På IKK er der efteroptaget 11 studerende, alle på enkelmoduler.

Der er efteroptaget 16 hel-på-del studerende – 14 på DPU og 2 på IKK.

Der var ansøgningsfrist for tompladsstuderende d. 8. juni, og ansøgningerne er nu færdigbehandlede. Der er optaget 387 tompladsstuderende, heraf 118 studerende på §1A.

### **Internationalisering**

666 nye udvekslingsstuderende er blevet indskrevet på Aarhus Universitet i efteråret 2023. Fordelingen på de enkelte fakulteter er: Arts 193; BSS 282; Health 36; NAT 86; TEK 69.

Arts Internationalisation er vært for et storstilet Arts *Intro Days*-arrangement i uge 34 og 35.

Hjemuniversiterne spænder bredt fra Alicante, Bergen, Caen, Faroe Islands, Galway, Keio, Leeds, Massachusetts, Otago, Peking, Rotterdam, Singapore, Victoria til Winnipeg m.m.

Der er som sædvanlig rift om de ledige pladser på de Internationale Valgfag. Det er dog bestemt en fordel, at enkelte IV-fag undervises på andre ugedage end mandag.

## USEFUL INFORMATION

### Changes in academic regulations as of 1 September 2023

On 1 September, changes were made in most of the academic regulations at the Faculty of Arts. This year, there was an unusually high number of changes in the academic regulations due to the removal of prerequisites. It is important that all teachers check whether any changes have been made in the academic regulations for the courses they teach. The current changes can be seen [here](#).

### Practical questions in connection with teaching activities

The new semester has just started, and the autumn courses have just got off the ground.

### Admissions to further and continuing education programmes after the application deadline

The application deadline for further and continuing education programmes (professional Master's degree programmes and part-time programmes) was 2 May, and the application deadline for late admission was 21 August. During this period, 59 students were admitted to a programme at DPU, including 18 to a full-time professional Master's degree programme. At the School of Culture and Society, 11 students were admitted to a programme after the application deadline, including 3 to a full-time professional Master's degree programme. At the School of Communication and Culture, 11 students were admitted after the application deadline, all to individual modules.

16 students were admitted to part-time programmes after the application deadline – 14 at DPU and 2 at the School of Communication and Culture.

The deadline for single-course students was 8 June, and the applications have now been processed. A total of 387 single-course students have been admitted, including 118 students under section 1A.

### Internationalisation

666 new exchange students were enrolled at Aarhus University in the autumn of 2023. They are studying at the following faculties: Arts 193; BSS 282; Health 36; NAT 86; TECH 69.

Arts Internationalisation hosted a major *Intro Days* event in weeks 34 and 35 (21 August - 1 September). The students come from universities as far apart as Alicante, Bergen, Caen, Faroe Islands, Galway, Keio, Leeds, Massachusetts, Otago, Peking, Rotterdam, Singapore, Victoria and Winnipeg.

### **Presentation for new exchange students by Study Centre Arts**

As in previous semesters, Study Centre Arts has given a presentation to new exchange students. The aim of this presentation was to prepare the students to take exams at Arts, to inform them of the most important rules and deadlines for exams, and to make sure they know who to contact if they have any problems with exams or need any other kind of help. Online presentations were also given to exchange students in Emdrup.

Arts Karriere has prepared 15 career-oriented events for Danish-speaking students at Arts and 5 for international students.

## IMPORTANT DEADLINES

### **Second attempt to submit Master's theses – deadline 15 September**

The submission deadline (second attempt) for students who failed to submit their Master's thesis at their first attempt on 1 June is Friday 15 September. This concerns 129 students at DPU, 91 students at the School of Communication and Culture and 61 students at the School of Culture and Society. The assessment deadline is 13 October. The deadline for students who fail to submit the Master's thesis at their second attempt is 29 September (third attempt).
