IV-fag E24-F25

Afdelingerne på IKK og IKS har indmeldt IV-fag for perioderne efteråret 2024 og foråret 2025. SNUK har kvalitetssikret de indkomne forslag, og studielederne har godkendt et sammenhængende udbud af IV-fag. I januar godkender studienævnene de IV-fag, der ikke tidligere har været udbudt. Fagene oprettes efterfølgende i systemerne, og de kursusansvarlige får mulighed for korrekturlæsning. De studerende tilmelder sig IV-fag for E24 i tidsrummet 1.-5. maj 2024.

Undervisningsmiljøundersøgelse (UMV)

Hvert 3. år udfører Aarhus Universitet en Undervisningsmiljøvurdering (UMV). Kortlægningen baserer sig på et udvalg af resultater fra den seneste afholdte nationale studenterundersøgelse: *Danmarks studieundersøgelse*. UMV er en vurdering af universitetets fysiske, psykiske og æstetiske miljø. Resultaterne af undervisningsmiljøvurderingen er tilgængelige i foråret 2024, og afdelingerne har herefter i samarbejde med uddannelsesnævnene til opgave at drøfte resultaterne og udpege, hvis der er områder, hvor der er behov for en indsats for at udvikle og sikre et godt undervisningsmiljø for studerende. Rota plan for degree programme evaluations at Arts

The rota plan showing when the faculty's degree programmes are to be evaluated has been updated for the period 2024-2028. The degree programmes that are to be evaluated this year will be informed (or have already been informed) about the process involved. Start-up meetings will be held in the spring.

Internationalisation electives in autumn 2024 and spring 2025

The departments at the School of Communication and Culture and the School of Culture and Society have submitted their proposals for internationalisation electives for autumn 2024 and spring 2025. SNUK has quality assured the proposals, and the directors of studies have approved a coherent range of internationalisation electives. In January, the boards of studies will approve the internationalisation electives which have not been offered previously. The electives will then be set up in the relevant systems, and the course coordinators can proofread the course descriptions.

Students register for internationalisation electives for autumn 2024 in the period 1-5 May 2024.

Teaching Environment Assessment (UMV)

Every 3 years, Aarhus University conducts a Teaching Environment Assessment (UMV). The mapping is based on a selection of results from the most recent national student survey: The Danish Student Survey. UMV is an assessment of the university's physical, psychological and aesthetic environment.

The results of the teaching environment assessment will be available in the spring of 2024, and in collaboration with the degree programme boards, the departments are responsible for discussing the results and identifying any areas in which special efforts are needed to develop and ensure a good teaching environment for students. It is a legal requirement that such efforts are made publicly available in the form of an action plan. For this purpose, a website is created. Find it [here](#)

DPU students to submit supervision plan by 15 January

DPU students who will be writing their Master’s thesis in spring 2024 must submit their supervision plan by 15 January. Until now, the supervision plan has been a PDF file to be filled in, signed and uploaded to the study portal. But now, it is an online form which Master’s thesis students fill in together with their supervisor and send directly to the head of department/Master’s thesis coordinator for approval.
