TIL ORIENTERING

Status på EVU-optag efter ansøgningsfristen 2. maj

2. maj var der ansøgningsfrist til EVU-udbuddet (Masteruddannelser og hel-på-del) på Arts for efteråret 2024. Der er inden fristen modtaget 59 ansøgninger til IKS, hvoraf 19 er ansøgninger til at starte på en fuld masteruddannelse. Der er modtaget 181 ansøgninger til DPU, hvoraf 63 er ansøgninger til opstart på en fuld uddannelse, og der er modtaget 129 ansøgninger til IKK, hvoraf 52 er ansøgninger til opstart på fuld uddannelse.

På uddannelser/kurser med ledige pladser er der efteroptag frem til d. 20. august.

Der er fortsat åbent for ansøgninger til tomplads på alle tre institutter. Her er ansøgningsfristen 8. juni.

USEFUL INFORMATION

Status of admissions to further and continuing education programmes after the application deadline on 2 May

At the Faculty of Arts, the application deadline for further and continuing education programmes (professional Master's and part-time degree programmes) in the autumn of 2024 was 2 May. The School of Culture and Society received 59 applications, including 19 for admission to a full professional Master's degree programme. The Danish School of Education received 181 applications, including 63 for admission to a full professional Master's degree programme. The School of Communication and Culture received 129 applications, including 52 for admission to a full professional Master's degree programme.

The deadline for applying for late admission to degree programmes/courses that have vacant places is 20 August 2024.

It is still possible to apply for admission under the available study place scheme (*tompladsordningen*) at all three schools. The application deadline is 8 June.

The new topic report on [intake at Danish universities](#) is now available in Power BI. In the report, you can find student intake figures based on data from the Ministry of Higher Education and Science for both Bachelor's and Master's degree programmes at Danish universities.
