Definition Location of origin:

Location of origin means the place where the researcher was residing or carrying out his/her main activity when taking up recruitment at the start of his/her initial training activities unless (s)he has resided or carried out his/her main activity for less than 12 months in this location immediately prior to this date. In the latter case, the location of origin is the capital of city of the country of his/her nationality. In case of a researcher holding more than one nationality, the location of origin is the capital of the city of the country where the researcher was residing for the longest period during the last 5 years prior to his/her recruitment.

According to the abovementioned definition my location of origin is:

Family is defined as persons linked to the researcher by (i) marriage, or (ii) a relationship with equivalent status to a marriage recognized by the national legislation of the country of the host organization or of the nationality of the researcher; or (iii) dependent children who are actually being maintained by the researcher.
