







# Horizon Client – installation guide for Mac

<p>This guide shows you how to install VMware Horizon Client on your Mac-computer to be able to file from the MS Office Suite,</p>		
Phase	Explanation	Navigation
<p><b>Open Managed Software Center</b></p>	<p>Find Managed Software Center (Cmd+Space)</p> <p>Search for "Horizon" and press <b>Install</b> on "VMware Horizon Client for Mac"</p> <p>If System Extension Blocked pops up: Press <b>Open Security Preferences</b> Press <b>Allow</b></p>	 
<p><b>Create shortcut (if you want to)</b></p>	<p>VMware Horizon is installed and can be found under Applications.</p> <p>You can create a short cut on your desktop (CMD+mouse og drag the icon to the desktop)</p>	
<p><b>Open Horizon Client</b></p>	<p>Press the icon.</p> <p>Type VDI.au.dk in the blue field.</p> <p>Press <b>Connect</b>.</p>	
<p><b>Log on to Horizon Client</b></p>	<p>Log in using your AU user.</p> <p>Username: Enter your AU ID e.g. AU123456</p> <p>Password: Use your normal password to your AU-computer</p> <p>Choose the virtual Workzone machine</p> <p>You are now able to open Outlook or Word and file documents using the virtual machine.</p>	 
<p><b>Log out of Horizon Client</b></p>	<p>You log out of the virtual machine by pressing <b>Start</b> in the bottom left corner and choosing the <b>off</b> button.</p>
