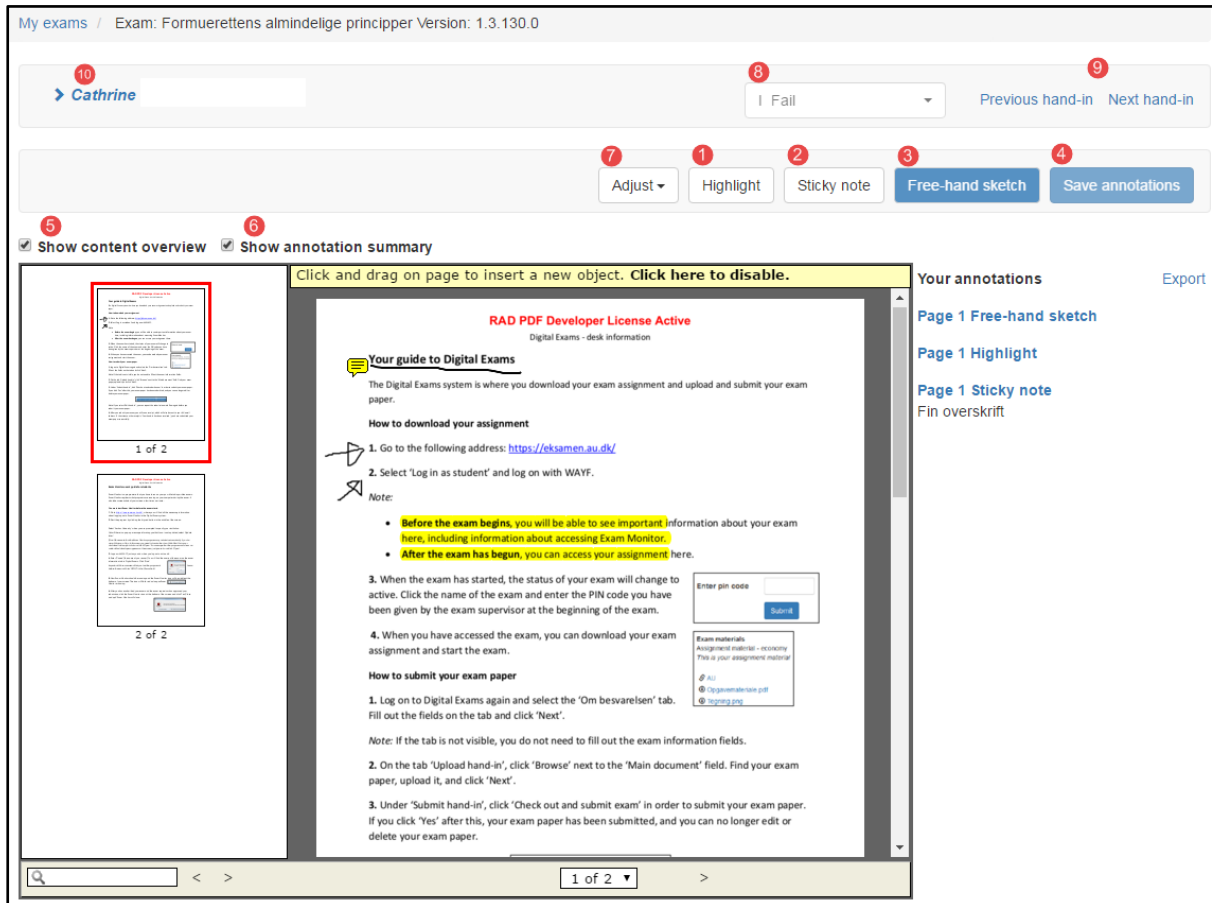


The annotation tool

If you open the exam paper by clicking 'Read in browser', you open the file in the online annotation tool.



The annotation dashboard gives you the following options:

1. You can use 'Highlight', which works like a highlighter pen.
2. You can select 'Sticky note', which works like a post-it note.
3. You can create a 'Free-hand sketch'.

Select the tool you want by clicking the relevant button. To erase an annotation, right-click the annotation and select 'delete annotation'.

4. Save your work by clicking 'Save annotations'.
5. You can show or hide the content overview by ticking and unticking the box.
6. You can show or hide the annotation summary by ticking and unticking the box.

7. You can adjust the zoom level by clicking this button.
8. You have the option of submitting a provisional grade/mark using this dropdown menu.
9. You can return to the previous exam paper or forward to the next exam paper here. Remember to save any changes to the current exam paper before doing so.
10. internal co-examiner You can view details about the exam paper, for example information about the hand-in and co-examiner contact information by clicking the name or group number here. You can also download the exam paper, the cover page or extra material here.
